Long considered an outsider, José Millán has had nothing given to him by the Argentine wine world and has had to fight for his place among industry leaders. Thanks to his tenacious attitude and determination to make the best wines, he has climbed to the top and earned the recognition of his peers with outstanding wines.

Appellation: Uco Valley

Grape varieties: 70% Malbec, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc, 5% Merlot.

Aging Process: 16 months in new French oak.

Alcohol Content – Vintage: 14% - 2013

Tasting Notes: Aromas of herbs and ripe berries intermixed with an earthy touch. 2013 was a cool year and produced wines with good tension and a perfect slow ripening. Both the palate and nose show that freshness with acid berry aromas and nicely integrated oak. The palate is medium-bodied, refreshing, tasty and simply an addictive wine.
